MAPS & DIRECTIONS

By Car

There is a multi-storey car park owned and managed by Birmingham City Council situated adjacent to Millennium Point. The car park can be accessed via Jennens Road. Millennium Point is clearly signposted from all main routes into the city – simply follow the brown tourist signs. The nearest motorways are the M6, M5 and M42.

By Rail

The nearest train station is Moor Street station -10 mins walk away, then New Street Station -15 mins walk away. Also Snowhill station is 15 mins walk away.
