

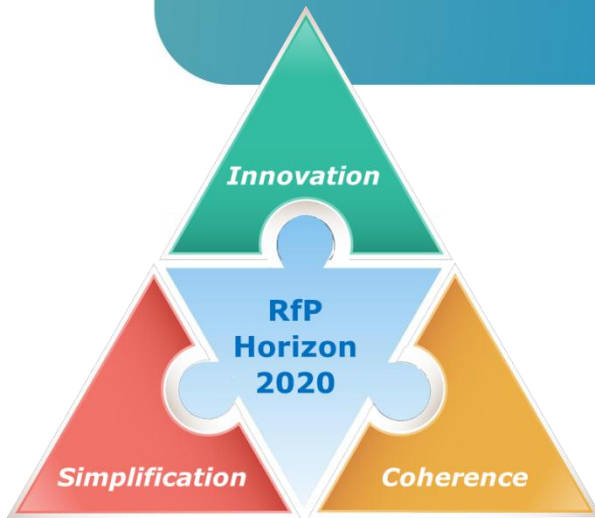

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# H2020 Rules for Participation



**Three main objectives:**  
**Innovation, Simplification and Coherence**  
*(single set of rules, funding rates, indirect cost model etc)*



## **Single set of rules**

- *Covering all H2020 research and innovation actions*
- *Keeping flexibility where needed*

**Call identifier: H2020-JTI-FCH-2014-1**

**Publication date: 09 July 2014**

**Deadline: 06 November 2014**

**Total budget: EUR 93 million**

**Indicative budget per pillars:**

## **1. TRANSPORT PILLAR**

- Research activities: **10 mill EUR**
- Innovation activities: **32 mill EUR**

## **2. ENERGY PILLAR**

- Research activities: **16 mill EUR**
- Innovation activities: **25.5 mill EUR**

## **3. OVERARCHING PROJECTS: 5 mill EUR**

## **4. CROSS-CUTTING: 4.5 mill EUR**

# Guiding principles for the evaluation

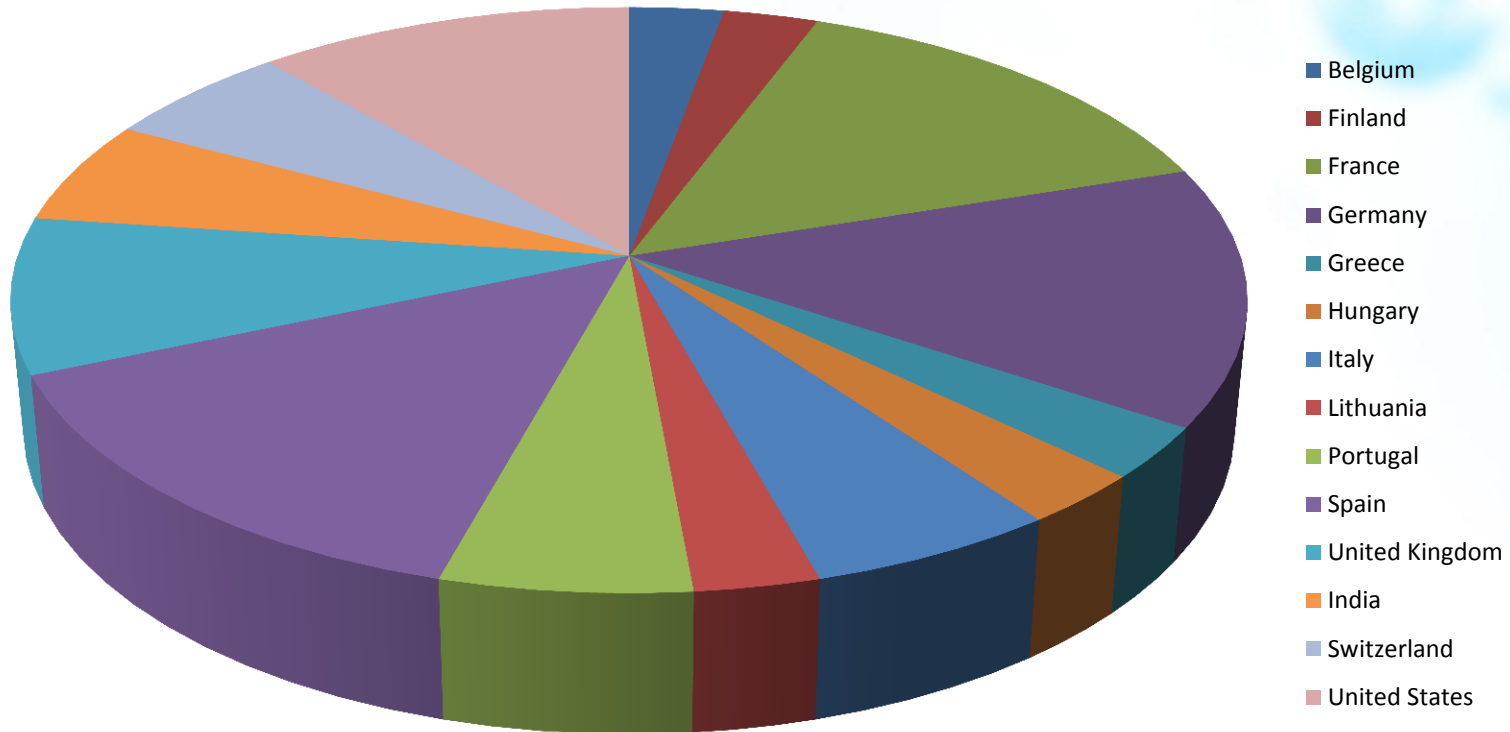
- ***Independence of the evaluators***
  - **No conflict of interest**
- ***Impartiality***
  - **Equal treatment of all proposals and evaluation based on their merits, irrespective of their origin or the identity of the applicants**
- ***Objectivity***
  - **Evaluation of each proposal as submitted; meaning on its own merit, not its potential if certain changes were to be made**
- ***Accuracy***
  - **Evaluation based on the official evaluation criteria and on the criteria addressed by the related topic**
- ***Consistency***
  - **Same standard of judgment to all proposals**



# Impact of grant preparation on evaluation

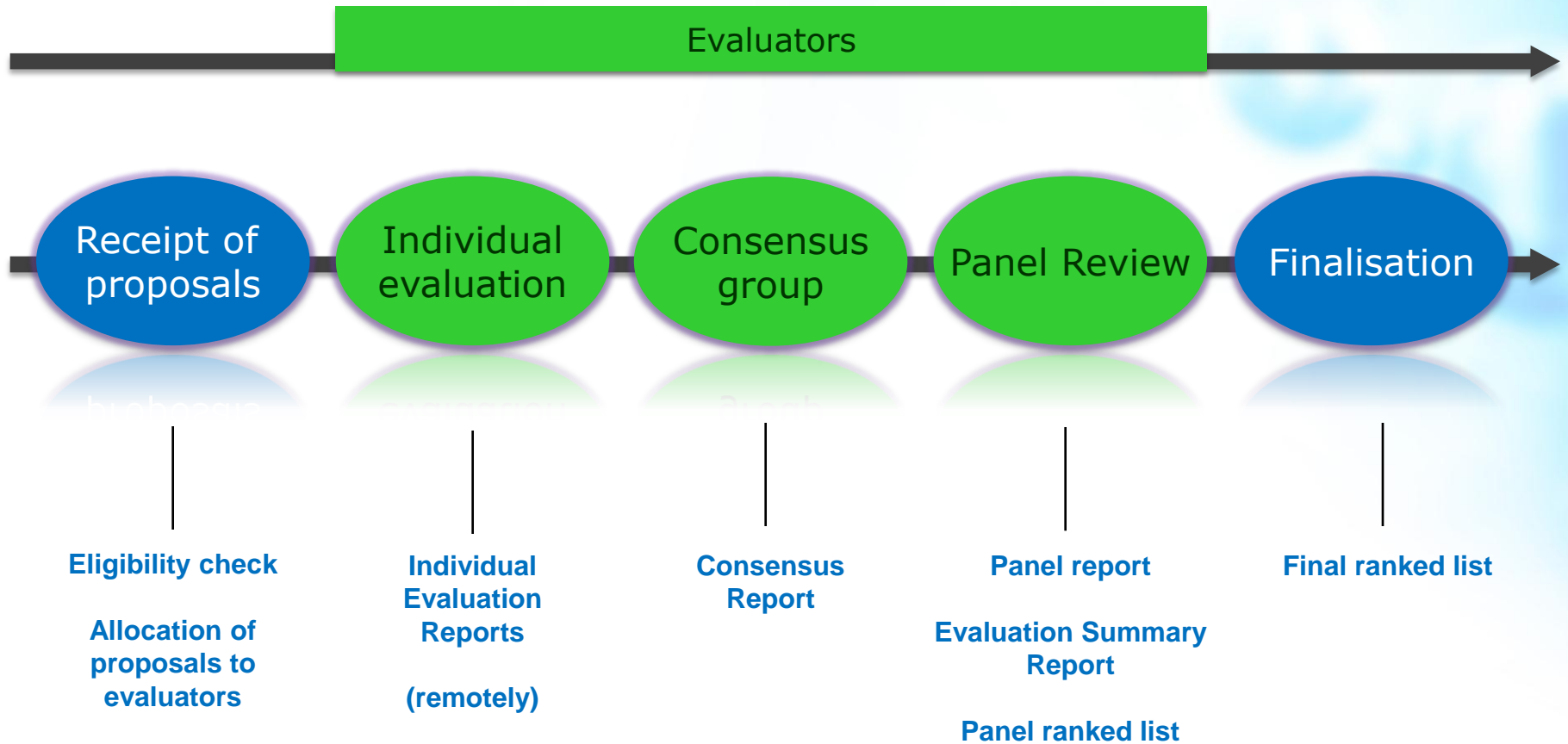
- **No grant negotiation phase!**
- **The time for evaluation and signature of the grant has been reduced to a maximum of 8 months**  
(max. 5 months\* for information of coordinators and max. 8 months\* for grant signature)
  - \*From the closure of the call
- **What does this mean for the evaluation of proposal?**
  - **Each proposal was evaluated as submitted**  
not on its potential if certain changes were to be made
  - **If shortcomings are identified (other than minor ones and obvious clerical errors), this is reflected in a lower score for the relevant criterion**
  - **The identified shortcomings are explained, but evaluators do not make recommendations**  
i.e. do not suggest additional partners, additional work packages, resources cut...
  - **Proposals with significant weaknesses that prevent the project from achieving its objectives or with resources being seriously over-estimated must not receive above-threshold scores**
  - **Any proposal with scores above the thresholds and for which there is sufficient budget will be selected as submitted**
