



Specific Service Privacy Statement **For data collected via** **On-line subscriptions to communication about the FCH 2 JU**

This privacy statement explains how the Fuel Cells and Hydrogen 2 Joint Undertaking (here after referred to as FCH2 JU) uses any information you give to us while registering for our newsletter, news alerts, invitations and other type of communication, and the way we protect your privacy.

1. Context and Controller:

This specific on-line service consists of on-line electronic registration made available on this web page, offering you the possibility to subscribe to receiving occasional news alerts, newsletters, invitations and other communication about the FCH 2 JU and its relevant activities. While registering, your personal data will be collected and further processed for the purposes detailed below under point 2. The relevant processing operation is under the responsibility of the Executive Director of the Fuel Cells and Hydrogen 2 Joint Undertaking, acting as the Controller.

As this on-line service collects and further processes personal data, Regulation (EC) 45/2001, of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2000 *on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Community institutions and bodies and on the free movement of such data*, is applicable.

2. What personal information do we collect, for what purpose and through which technical means?

Types of personal data

The **personal data collected** and further processed by the FCH 2 JU in relation to the on-line services are:

- Data necessary for the organisation and management of communication activities, such as:

(* Replies to this question are mandatory since all information requested is necessary for registration. In case of a no reply, the registration will not be carried out.)

Purpose and technical means

The purpose of processing personal data for the on-line service is to send to you by email occasional news alerts, newsletters, invitations and other communication about the FCH 2 JU and its relevant

activities, as well as the creation of a database of subscribers with contact details (email address) for future communications.

Legal basis

The **legal basis** for the organisation of the subscription process, including its management and the related processing, is Council Regulation (EU) No 559/2014 of 6 May 2014 *establishing the Fuel Cells and Hydrogen 2 Joint Undertaking*, more specifically Articles 1, 7, and 9 of the Statutes of The Fuel Cells and Hydrogen 2 Joint Undertaking, in corroboration with Regulation (EU) No 1291/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2013 *establishing Horizon 2020 - the Framework Programme for Research and Innovation (2014-2020)*.

In line with Article 5(a) of Regulation EC 45/2001 the processing operation is necessary for the performance of tasks carried out in the public interest on the basis of the Treaties or other legal instruments adopted on the basis thereof¹. The lawfulness of the processing of personal data is also based on Article 13 (1) of the Directive 2002/58/EC whereby the data subject has unambiguously given its consent, which corresponds to the data subject's consent in Article 5(d) of Regulation EC 45/2001.

By subscribing to this on-line service, the applicant will be considered to have given his or her consent to the processing of their data in the context of this conference.

3. Who has access to your information and to whom is it disclosed?

For the purposes detailed above access to your personal data is given to the following persons:

- Internally authorized staff of the FCH 2 JU
- Internally authorized staff of FCH 2 JU contractors in charge of executing activities for the organization of the event.

4. How do we protect and safeguard your information?

The personal data and all information collected related to the above-mentioned event is stored on the servers of the FCH 2 JU, the operations of which abide by the FCH 2 JU's security decisions and provisions established for this kind of servers and services. This includes the Common It Security Policy, implemented by the FCH2 JU, applying the security measures described in the Commission Decision C (2006)3602 concerning the security of information systems used by the European Commission, Implementing Rules for the Commission Decision C(2006)3602, Standards on Information Systems Security, Complementary information systems security policy and control measures as applied to specific applications by respective system owners

Access to all collected personal data is only permitted to those referred to above (see point 3) using a User ID / Password. If support of contractors is necessary, please note that the FCH 2 JU applies organizational measures, which include appropriate specific access rights and controls.

5. How can you verify, modify or delete your information?

You are entitled to access the personal data the FCH 2 JU holds about you and to have them rectified where necessary. In certain cases, you also have the right to have your data blocked or erased or to object to their processing. For more information, please see Articles 13 to 19 of the Regulation.

To exercise any of these rights, please send an e-mail to the functional mailbox (see point 7 below, 'Contact Information'). We will reply within three months. Please note that in some cases restrictions under Article 20 of the Regulation may apply.

Attention is drawn to the consequences of a delete request, which means that all your contact details will be lost.

6. How long do we keep your data?

All personal data will be kept for a general retention period of five years.

Your personal data will also be part of a list of contact details shared internally amongst the staff of FCH 2 JU for the purpose of contacting you in the future in the context of other FCH 2 JU communication activities. If you do not agree with this, please contact the Controller by using the contact information below and by explicitly specifying your request. The said contact list will be kept for a period of five years.
